We will ride on the wonderful Jacobite Steam train, (made famous in the Harry Potter movie as Harry's transport to Hogwarts !) On board we fly over the spectacular Glenfinnan Viaduct. We'll visit the Isles of Mull and of Iona, (the latter, the birthplace of Celtic Christianity.) No tour of Scotland would be complete without Loch Lomond and we'll stay right on its banks and take a morning cruise. Our final stop is the vibrant and welcoming city of Glasgow which offers much to explore and from which we strike out to see even more! We fly home from Glasgow at tour's end.*
